Resolution #15-24

**SUPPORT FOR COLLABORATION BETWEEN THE SIOUX LOOKOUT FIRST NATIONS HEALTH AUTHORITY
AND THE SIOUX LOOKOUT OUT OF THE COLD**

WHEREAS, it is estimated that 95% of the clients who use the services of the Sioux Lookout Out of the Cold are from one of the First Nations in the Sioux Lookout area; and

WHEREAS, there are approximately 200 persons that are medical patients and escorts who are housed annually at Out of the Cold for overnight accommodation, and sometimes for extended stays, who are unable to stay at the Jeremiah McKay Kabayshewekamik (hostel);

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Chiefs in Assembly directs Sioux Lookout First Nations Health Authority (SLFNHA) to work with the Out of the Cold to find ways to house medical clients at the emergency shelter when the patients and escorts cannot safely be accommodated at the Jeremiah McKay Kabayshewekamik (hostel).


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the Chiefs in Assembly direct SLFNHA to explore ways to formalize a partnership to ensure seamless services for individuals who normally reside on reserve so that services initiated in Sioux Lookout can be transitioned to their home communities when the patients return.


