APPROACHES TO COMMUNITY WELLBEING CHIEFS' AND HEALTH DIRECTORS' MEETING**

Resolution #15-05

GOLDCORP CONTRIBUTION TO SIOUX LOOKOUT ZONE APPOINTMENT CLINIC

WHEREAS the First Nations people from the 31 communities in the Sioux Lookout area are attending medical appointments in Sioux Lookout at a facility that is outdated and not up to modern standards; and

WHEREAS the First Nations people should have access to a medical facility that is up to standards that are available to other residents of Sioux Lookout; and

WHEREAS Sioux Lookout First Nations Health Authority (SLFNHA) has continued to lobby the federal government to provide a new and permanent facility in Sioux Lookout but have not received any commitment from the government; and

WHEREAS Goldcorp has a longstanding and significant presence in the area and has established priorities, such as health and community development, to support local communities in areas it has operations;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Chiefs-in-Assembly direct SLFNHA to work with the Chiefs Committee on Health to approach Goldcorp for its support to establish a new Primary Health Care Facility in Sioux Lookout.


FINALLY BE IT RESOLVED THAT this resolution will not negatively affect other agreements or existing and ongoing negotiations that communities have with Goldcorp.


