**PURCHASE OF FIBROSCAN DEVICE FOR SIOUX LOOKOUT AREA**


**WHEREAS**, the Chiefs in Assembly are concerned about the health issues revolving around liver conditions in residents from the First Nation communities in the Sioux Lookout region; and

**WHEREAS**, a portable device known as a FibroScan, also called transient elastography, is used to assess liver stiffness without invasive investigation and allows physicians to diagnose and monitor fibrosis;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Chiefs in Assembly direct Sioux Lookout First Nations Health Authority (SLFNHA) to work with Sioux Lookout Meno Ya Win Health Centre on exploring funding options such as hospital funding, research initiatives, and fundraising activities to purchase a FibroScan for Sioux Lookout and area.


