## Are you at risk for HEPATITIS B, HEPATITIS C or HIV?

Have you ever:	□ Had sex without a condom?
	□ Had oral sex?
	□ Used a needle that was used by someone else? (for drugs, piercings, tattoos)
	□ Used drug tools that were used by someone else? (pipes, straws, spoons, filters, water)
	□ Shared sex toys?

If you answered 'yes' to any of these questions **GET TESTED**.

## PROTECT YOURSELF, YOUR FAMILY, YOUR FRIENDS.

- Always use lubricated condoms for sex (vaginal or anal)
- · Use dental dams or condoms for oral sex
- · Never use someone else's needles, spoons, straws, water, filters or pipes
- Get tested and treated for sexually transmitted infections
- · For your general health, you should never reuse needles

FOR CONDOMS, CLEAN NEEDLES, TESTING and IMMUNIZATIONS go to your local nursing station or health unit
