Resolution #15-22

HEALTH CARE SERVICES ACCOUNTABILITY

WHEREAS, the Sioux Lookout area Chiefs in Assembly recognize that many community members have identified issues with the primary health care system that have resulted in delayed assessments, delayed diagnosis, misdiagnosis, and delayed/inappropriate treatment; and

WHEREAS, there have been deaths resulting from these issues within the primary health care system in the communities; and

WHEREAS, the Chiefs in Assembly passed Resolution #14-10 "Review of Nursing Services in the Sioux Lookout Area" but the resolution did not include the whole primary health care system;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Chiefs in Assembly direct the Sioux Lookout First Nations Health Authority (SLFNHA) to conduct a review of services provided by Health Canada First Nations Inuit Health Branch (FNIHB), Ministry of Health and Long Term Care (MOHLTC), and other agencies that provide Primary Health Care.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the Chiefs in Assembly direct SLFNHA to take a lead role in developing a process to address potential incidents, investigate and ensure patient safety.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED THAT, the Chiefs in Assembly direct SLFNHA to include in the review, the range of services required to provide a primary health care system, which models a multidisciplinary team approach.


