APPOINTMENT OF SIOUX LOOKOUT AREA REPRESENTATIVE TO HEALTH ACCORD TASK FORCE

WHEREAS, the Canada Health Accord is an agreement between the provinces, territories and federal government. It provides the provinces with funding and sets national standards; and

WHEREAS, the Health Accord process, for the first time, includes the Assembly of First Nations (AFN) in the process; and

WHEREAS, the AFN has developed a Task Force to support the negotiation of the upcoming Health Accord; and

WHEREAS, the AFN seeks a representative with health experience working with Sioux Lookout area First Nations communities to sit on the Task Force;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Chiefs in Assembly direct SLFNHA, Chiefs Committee on Health, and Nishnawbe Aski Nation, to select a representative that understands community health issues to sit on the Task Force.
