**SIOUX LOOKOUT FIRST NATIONS HEALTH AUTHORITY  
APPROACHES TO COMMUNITY WELLBEING CHIEFS' AND HEALTH DIRECTORS' MEETING**

**Resolution #15-03**

**APPROVAL OF THE APPROACHES TO COMMUNITY WELLBEING MODEL**

**WHEREAS**, we have a treaty relationship with the Federal Government and with the Government of Ontario, that outlines a treaty right to health for First Nations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sioux Lookout area Chiefs in Assembly, under resolution 10-06, directed the Sioux Lookout First Nations Health Authority to take the lead on establishing a tri-partite process between Sioux Lookout area First Nations, First Nations and Inuit Health – Ontario Region, and the Province of Ontario; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sioux Lookout area Chiefs in Assembly, under resolution 10-06, directed the Sioux Lookout First Nations Health Authority, in collaboration with the Chiefs Committee on Health, to develop a negotiations framework that will support the tri-partite table securing the necessary resources to establish and implement a fully-integrated culturally appropriate regional public health system as envisioned in the Anishinabe Health Plan and to be guided by the public health report; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sioux Lookout First Nations Health Authority received a three-year funding grant from Health Canada, through the Health Services Integration Fund, to establish and implement an integrated public health system; and

**WHEREAS**, Sioux Lookout First Nations Health Authority has developed a framework to Approaches to Community Wellbeing and will continue to develop an implementation plan, which will be brought to the Sioux Lookout area Chiefs for approval;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the Chiefs in Assembly direct the Federal Government and the Government of Ontario to recognize and support a First Nations driven model to Approaches to Community Wellbeing; and

**THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT**, the Chiefs in Assembly approve the draft Approaches to Community Wellbeing model, which is described in the report "Approaches to Community Wellbeing: Model Explanation - DRAFT" dated February 2015 and drafted by the Sioux Lookout First Nations Health Authority; and


