APPROACHES TO COMMUNITY WELLBEING CHIEFS' AND HEALTH DIRECTORS' MEETING**

**Resolution #15-04**

**APPROVAL OF THE TRANSITION PLAN FOR THE APPROACHES TO COMMUNITY WELLBEING**

**WHEREAS**, the Chiefs in Assembly mandated the Sioux Lookout First Nations Health Authority, through resolution 10-06, to develop a regional integrated First Nations governed public health system for the Sioux Lookout area; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chiefs have approved the draft model for the public health system, entitled Approaches to Community Wellbeing, which includes a transition plan for moving forward; and

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the Chiefs in Assembly direct the Sioux Lookout First Nations Health Authority to work with representatives from Tribal Councils and the Independent Communities to carry out the aforementioned transition plan; and


**THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT**, the Chiefs in Assembly direct the Sioux Lookout First Nations Health Authority to engage agencies and groups that have relationships with communities to support the work of Approaches to Community Wellbeing; and

**THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT**, the Chiefs in Assembly direct the Sioux Lookout First Nations Health Authority to seek funding to continue with the Approaches to Community Wellbeing transition plan.


**FINALLY BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the Chiefs in Assembly direct the Sioux Lookout First Nations Health Authority to develop an implementation plan and a formal agreement, which is to be presented back to the Chiefs by March 2017.
