An assessment

Will be conducted with clients, which can occur at home, school, in a community setting and/or by video conference/ telehealth. After the assessment is complete, a report is written providing recommendations that can be reviewed with client, families, and caregivers.

A therapy plan may include, but is not limited to:

Working together with children and their families, caregivers, daycare/ school staff and other agencies to provide individualized treatment plans suitable to the child and family's strengths and needs. Treatment may involve teaching families strategies to use at home, working with children directly on sounds or language skills, training school/ daycare staff to support children outside of the home, or any combination of these items.
